Welcome to Regina Caeli Parish! Please be patient with us as we settle in, set up our facilities and establish a routine. The construction crew and volunteers have worked late every day for weeks, including the evening before the October 29th blessing ceremony. Construction crews were out again this past week putting finishing touches on the building and will return this week. Volunteers continue to complete the side altars and other interior items. Office and class equipment, and various needed amenities and supplies are in the process of being purchased and/or installed. This additional work is being done by volunteers who juggle their schedules to help out. Many of them have been doing this for several years. Their sacrifices are especially appreciated as Regina Caeli struggles with a tight budget and the uncertainty of operating costs at our new location.

Official office hours will be announced soon. Until then, please note that the building will be open for private prayer 30 minutes before each Mass.

This Sunday is the first day of CCD at the property and we have fewer rooms than at our prior location. All available space after the 9:30 a.m. Mass will be used by the catechism classes, including the hallway and sanctuary. We are working on alternate solutions, but for now, please understand the situation.

God has blessed us with a new home and every new home has possibilities and difficulties. It will take time to smooth out all the kinks, but we will get there. Please be patient and charitable as we work through the new challenges together.
