From the Pastor

Series on the Mass, Part 37

There are three parts to the Preface: the introduction, the body of the Preface, and the conclusion.

The introduction is first of all a thanksgiving to God for all that He is: Almighty and Everlasting. It is addressed to the Father but through the Son. The priest is also addressing God using the first person plural since he is speaking on behalf of all present. This part of the preface changes very little from preface to preface.

The second part is the body of the preface, which adapts to the various feast days and liturgical seasons. We always have reason to worship God, but some feast days or liturgical seasons add an extra important element that is brought out in the preface. These prefaces give very short but rich doctrinal teachings concerning the subject of the special preface. If there is no particular preface for a feast day, then the common preface is used.

The conclusion calls upon the adoration of the angels, who never cease to adore God in heaven. Some of the choirs of angels are mentioned in the prefaces, though they do not all have the same list or necessarily even mention all of them. The nine choirs of angels are: the Angels, Archangels, Thrones, Dominations, Principalities, Powers, Virtues, Cherubim, and Seraphim. After the mention of the angels, it is only fitting that the hymn of the angels to the Holy Trinity be sung: *Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God of Hosts...*
