30th Anniversary of the FSSP, Part 1

On October 18th, the Feast of St. Luke the Evangelist, the Fraternity of St. Peter (FSSP) celebrated its 30th year since its founding. In the decree of erection, the Pontifical Commission Ecclesia Dei erected the FSSP as a society of apostolic life of Pontifical Right. The decree points out that our goal is the sanctification of priests through the exercise of a pastoral ministry, particularly in conforming our life to the Most Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and observing the liturgical and disciplinary traditions invoked by the Roman Pontiff, St. John Paul II, in the Apostolic Letter Ecclesia Dei of July 2nd, 1988. St. John Paul II reminded us in this document that "It is impossible to remain faithful to the Tradition while breaking the ecclesial bond with him to whom, in the person of the Apostle Peter, Christ himself entrusted the ministry of unity in his Church."

After 30 years, the Fraternity remains faithful to this goal and continues to grow as a Society of Apostolic Life in full communion with our Holy Father, exercising our priestly vocation while celebrating the Traditional Liturgy and Sacraments.
